FEEDING DIRECTIONS

- 1. Purina®'s CREEP FEEDS should be offered to beef calves on a free choice, continuous basis when pasture quality begins to decline, approximately 50 to 80 days pre-weaning.
- Calves should consume CREEP FEEDS at a daily rate of 1% of body weight. Never allow creep feeders to run out of feed.

MANAGEMENT TIPS

- Locate near water, mineral or primary grazing areas.
- · Introduce when pasture quality is declining.
- Keep dry and fresh for consistent palatability.
- Never allow creep feeders to run out of product.
- Frequently check feeders to monitor consumption.
